
# How To Make A Claim





Workplace accidents are common, but injured workers are often reluctant to seek compensation because they fear for their job. ### What Is Your Claim Worth?





### STEP 1 -

You should seek medical attention immediately. If you are treated by a first aider, follow this up by attending the local hospital or your GP. Your medical records will be an important part of your claim. Failing to seek medical attention may worsen your injuries and slow your recovery.



### STEP 2 -

Report your accident to your employer or supervisor and make a note of their name and position. It is also advisable that you note the date and time that this was done.



### STEP 3 -

Complete an accident report form. Often your employer will complete this so check the details are correct before you sign the document and if possible take a copy. Alternatively ensure the accident is noted in the firm's accident book.



### STEP 4 -

Did anyone see your accident? Obtain the name, address and contact details for any witnesses.





### STEP 5 -

If possible take photographs of the scene of the accident.



### STEP 6 -

Also obtain photographs of your injuries. They will form part of your evidence in your claim.
